The Awards are open to all Free to Air & Cable channels, Press, Magazines operating in India. Campaigns must have commenced between January 1st 2016 and December 31st 2016

Categories:

- a. Best Telly Program on Rural Markets/Consumers
- b. Best individual coverage of Rural Markets/Consumers (all media) Awarded to the best television program and individual coverage/article on emerging rural markets, rural consumer research, rural trends etc

Provided that it is relevant, a campaign **CAN** be entered into multiple categories.

The Entry Process:

- Submissions can also be submitted in video format. Please note the format of a video entry MUST follow the same template as a written submission.
- Entries will ONLY be accepted via our entry form and Template.
- Attachments images/charts/video etc. can be submitted as part of an entry provided they are relevant.
- The closing date for entries is 20th March, 2017

Complete Entries:

A complete entry should contain the following elements:

- One completed entry form for each entry
- The appropriate entry fee
- Your submission
- Any relevant attachments charts, images, audio, video etc (Please keep these to a minimum and attach a list of any attachments)
